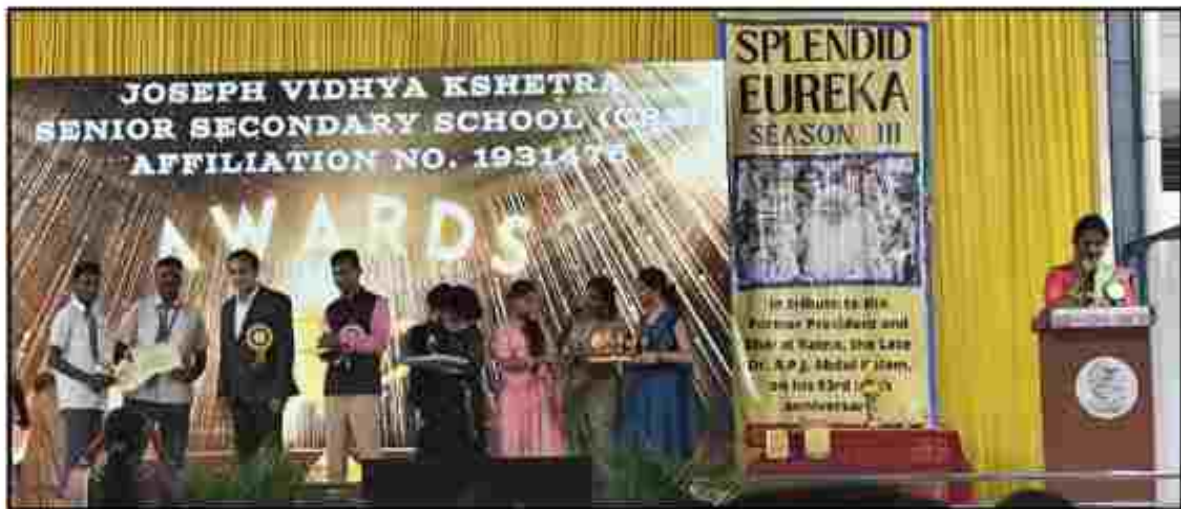

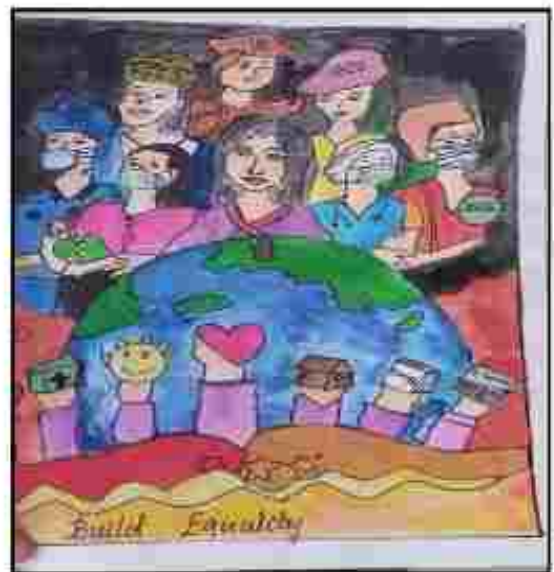
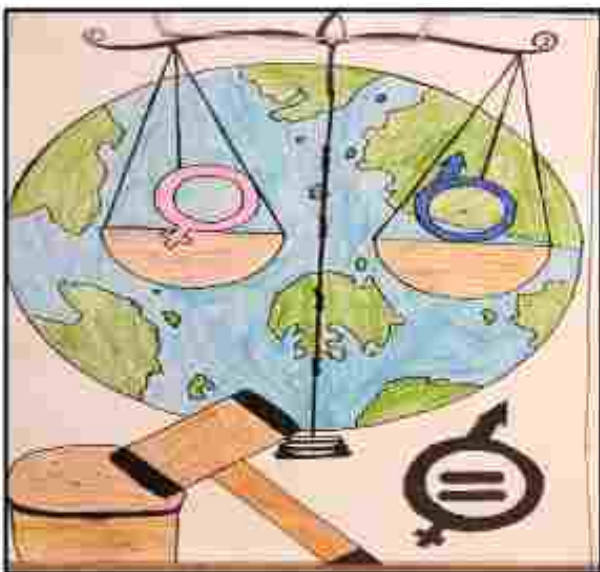
INDIA CONSTITUTION DAY

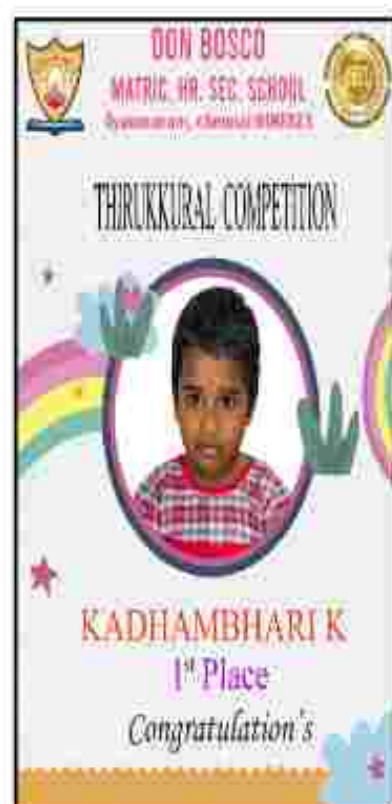
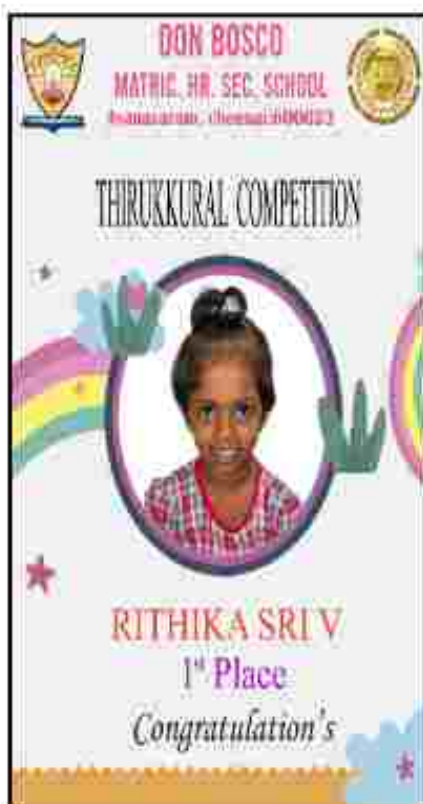

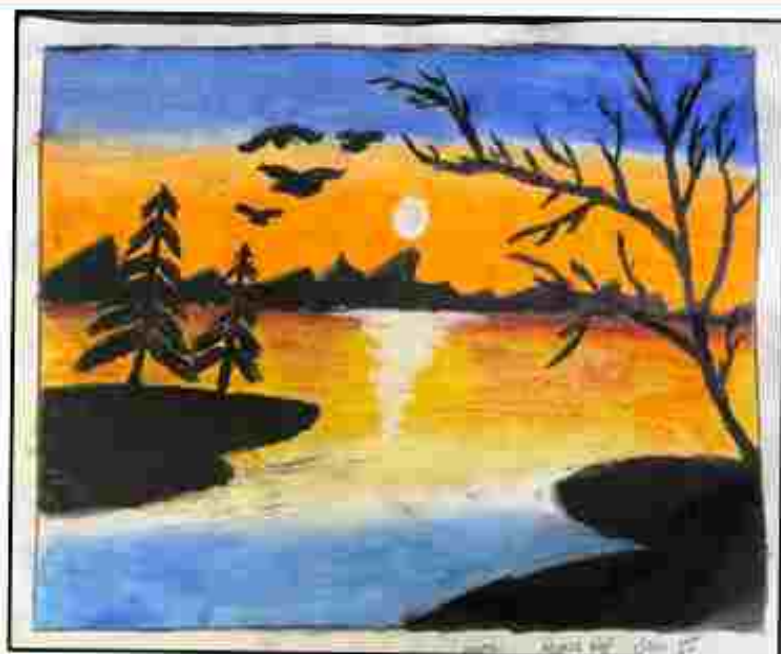
