Annual Day Celebration – 21.01.2025

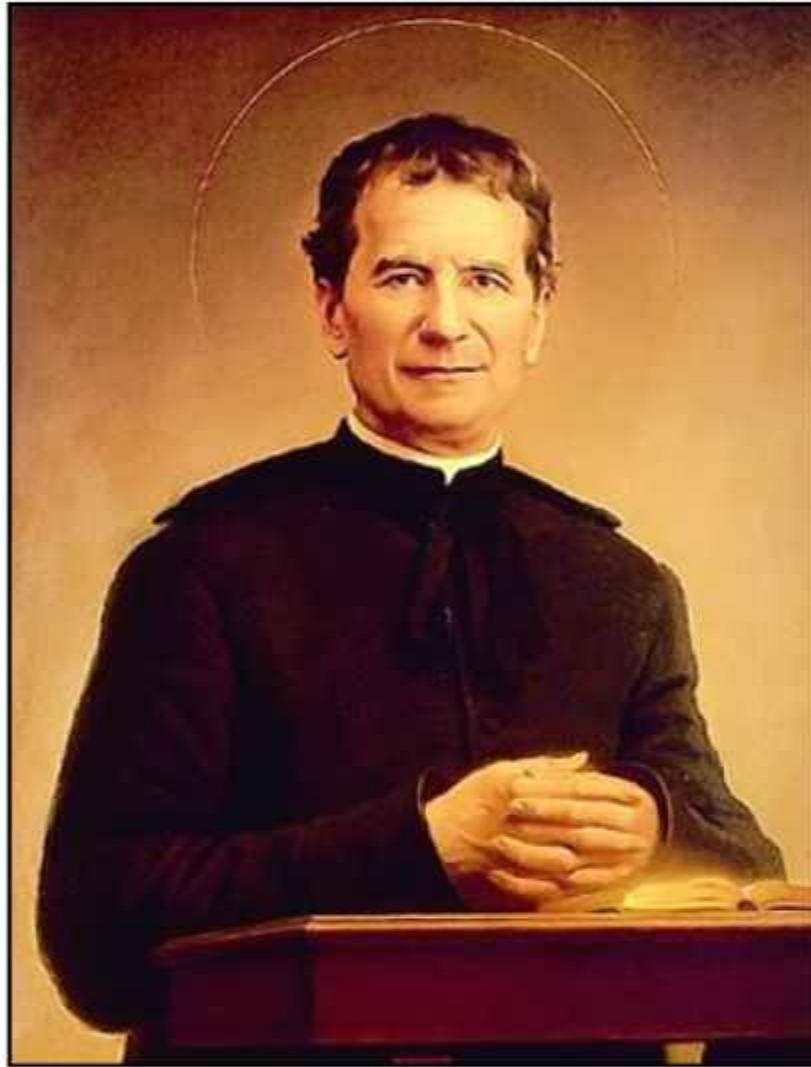

Condensation – Explained by Jeevesh (Class IV)

Condensation is the process of water vapour turning into liquid water. It occurs when gas molecules slow down and come together to form a liquid. This happens when gas transfers its energy to something cooler.

Condensation is the opposite of evaporation. It occurs in various ways:

- Cooling the air: When air cools to its dew point.
- Saturation: When the air is full of water vapour.

Examples:

- Morning dew on leaves.
 - Foggy windshields on cold mornings.
 - Steam condensing on mirrors after hot showers.
